Big Idea

Jesus promises us He will always be with us.

Scripture

Romans 8:38-39
Hebrews 13:5-6
Matthew 26:36-46

Discussion Questions

1 – What is the difference between being alone and loneliness? Tell of a time when you felt lonely.

2 – Have you ever thought of Jesus feeling lonely? What are times talked about in the sermon that pointed out loneliness for Jesus?

3 – Do you feel there is anything you've done that makes you feel unlovable? What does Romans 8:38-39 tell us about God's love for us?

4 – Read Hebrews 13:5-6. What does it mean to you that God will never abandon you? What can you do to help you remember this truth?

5 – Read Matthew 26:36-46. What did Jesus do during a time of loneliness and grief? What can we learn from His example?

Next Steps

Do a search of all verses that talk of God being with you and His love for you. Take the time to write some of them down so you can be reminded of these truths during times of loneliness.

Prayer Focus

Ask God to help you become more aware of His presence in your life and to help you feel His love instead of loneliness.
