Big Idea

Discussion Questions

1 – Describe the greatest physical pain you have ever felt. The sermon gave us an idea of the amount of suffering Jesus went through on the cross. Does your worst pain give you a picture of the physical pain Christ suffered? Explain.

2 – Read Psalm 22 and discuss how it compares to Jesus' crucifixion and what He said in Mark 15:34. How does Isaiah 52:13-53:12 compare to Jesus' suffering and death?

3 – Read Luke 23:34. What does this verse tell us about the nature of Jesus Christ? How does Jesus' example toward his accusers affect you?

4 –According to Romans 3:23-26, why was it important that Jesus be without sin? What do these verses tell us about the impact of Jesus' sacrifice?

5 – Romans 3:23-26 tells us all who believe in Jesus are made right with God. What does this tell you about God's love?

Next Steps

Spend time reflecting on Jesus' suffering and sacrifice. Last week we learned Jesus told us to live as He lived. What sacrifice do you need to make to love someone this week?

Prayer Focus

Thank God for making a plan to cleanse us from our sins once and for all through Jesus. Ask God to show you who you know to share this amazing love.
