Big Idea

Discussion Questions

5 – How can the church/your small group help you to do what you have been prompted to do by the Holy Spirit through this sermon and the scriptures just read?

- Revisit questions 3-4 throughout the week to ensure you are prayerfully taking the steps you needed to apply what the Holy Spirit has spoken to you.
- Part of the *why* behind the "Epicenter" series is to really know the purpose of Christ and the basic scriptures supporting that, so we can share such truth confidently with others. Try memorizing some of the points and scriptures so you are prepared to share hope...CHRIST!
