Big Idea

Scripture

Zechariah 9:9

Discussion Questions

1 – Just for fun, name some noteworthy kings.

2 – Read Zechariah 9:9 What does the prophet say Jerusalem will do? How does the prophet say the king will arrive?

3 – Read Luke 19:29-31 and see how specific Jesus gets with his instructions. Read on through verse 38. Does it happen as Zechariah predicted? What do you think of this?

4 – Read Luke 19:38-44. Why did Jesus sob during his parade?

5- The sermon detailed how we, just like the palm wavers, miss King Jesus when we look to him to “use His Power” to do what we want. What does Jesus long for instead?

Next Steps

Set a timer for three minutes. Ask God to bless your imagination. Close your eyes and imagine you are in Jerusalem on the first “Palm Sunday,” standing by the side of the road as Jesus passes by you on the young donkey. What do you think of him? How do you feel watching him?

Prayer Focus

Ask God to help you to want Him more than the things that He can do for you.

Ask Him to give you a faithful spirit.
