**Big Idea**

Our posture of battle in the spiritual realm is surrender.

**Scripture**

Ephesians 6:10-12

Ephesians 2:4-5

Revelation 12:10b

Psalm 23:5

**Discussion Questions**

1 – We all tend to elevate the character or person who has a warrior heart. In thinking throughout history and/or movies, etc. which character that fits that description resonates the most with you?

2 – Read Ephesians 6:10-12 and make note of the stance God tells us to take once we “put on the full armor of God”. What does He tell us to do in the face of the devil’s schemes?

3 – Read Revelation 12:10b. What is lie about yourself that the devil knows rocks you to your core? How does Satan use others to steal your joy and freedom?

4 – What is one “fight” or “battle” that you just keep on insisting you handle the unnecessary bulk of that you need to surrender?

5 – Read Psalm 23:5. God loves us SO deeply. And Satan is so disarmed when we surrender and trust and find joy in the victory already won. What does it do to Satan when we rest versus react frantically to the fiery darts he is trying to throw at us?

**Next Steps**

- Remember the battle is not yours and yours alone. SURRENDER...regularly and completely the battles you are tempted to fight.
